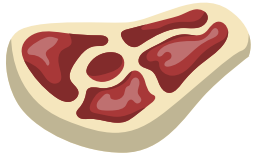
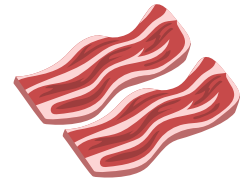




Have you been bitten by a tick?

Do you have unexplained anaphylaxis, hives, abdominal pain, reflux, or arthritis?

You may have Alpha-gal Syndrome.
